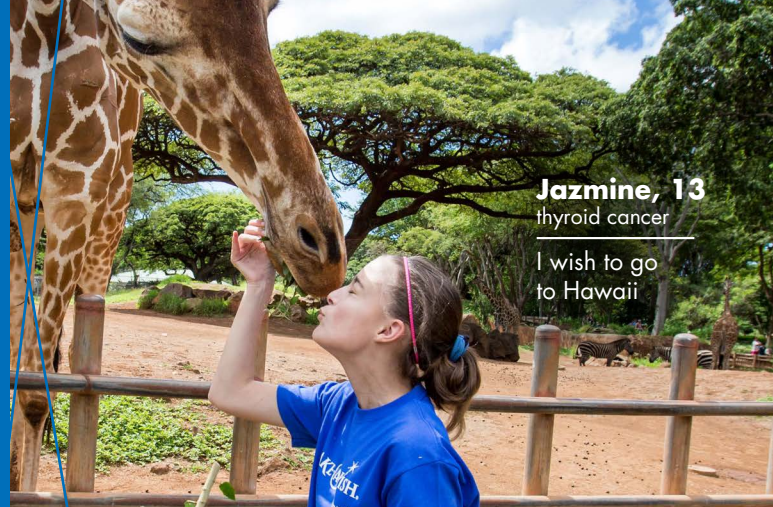

DEAR ENDOCRINOLOGY HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL,

Please review the eligibility guidance to help identify children within your department that may qualify for a wish. Thank you for helping us reach our vision of granting every eligible child's wish.

Note: Please refer to the other specialties to learn about other qualifying conditions.

To qualify for a wish, a child must:

- ① Be over the age of 2½ and under the age of 18 at the time of referral
- ② Not have received a wish from another wish-granting organization
- ③ Be diagnosed with a life-threatening condition; i.e. a progressive, degenerative or malignant condition that has placed the child's life in jeopardy

USUALLY QUALIFYING ENDOCRINOLOGY CONDITIONS:

- Disorder of glycosaminoglycan metabolism
- Disorder of urea cycle metabolism
- Fabry (Anderson) disease
- Gaucher disease
- Hyperinsulinism with persistent hypoglycemia after pancreatectomy
- Krabbe disease
- Lesch-Nyhan syndrome
- Maple-syrup-urine disease
- Metachromatic leukodystrophy
- Multiple endocrine neoplasia syndromes with evidence of cancer
- Neimann-Pick disease
- Panhypopituitarism requiring hormone replacement with hydrocortisone and/or desmopressin
- Peroxisomal disorder
- Prader Willi syndrome with comorbidities
- Sphingolipidosis
- Tay-Sachs disease
- Thyroid cancer
 - Requiring chemotherapy infusions or radiation treatment and referred within one year of completion of the above mentioned treatment
- X-linked adrenoleukodystrophy (all others will be reviewed on a case by case basis)

Other conditions may be eligible for a wish with complicating co-morbidities.
