

## **GENETICS**Referral Guidance Sheet



## To qualify for a wish, a child must meet these criteria at the time of referral:

- 1. Older than 2½ years and under 18 years
- 2. Has not received a wish from another wish-granting organization
- 3. Diagnosed with a condition currently placing the child's life in jeopardy

## **Usually qualifying Genetics conditions:**

- Barth syndrome
- Congenital anomaly, chromosomal, or single gene condition with associated life-threatening complications such as:
  - o Intractable seizures
  - o Structural upper airway abnormalities or chronic pulmonary symptoms
  - o Heart anomalies meeting cardiology guidance
  - o Chronic renal failure
  - o Associated major gastrointestinal dysfunctions

- Skeletal dysplasias or dysostoses with chronic or degenerative pulmonary complications
- Smith-Lemli-Opitz syndrome
- Trisomy 13 and 18
